We all have the capacity to glimpse a number of possible futures


We do this through

1. generate creative conversations and


2. tell new stories that emerge from these creative conversations.




Three Horizons







Horizon One (HI)



Approach:


- * How we get things done today 'locked in'
- * Incremental innovation framed by familiar approaches and dominant actors
- * Quantitative sense of time as limited resource

The dominant system at present

'business as usual'.

We rely on these systems being stable and reliable but as the world changes, so aspects of business as usual begin to feel out of place or no longer fit for purpose.

Eventually business as usual will be superseded by new ways of doing things.



Approach:


- * Transformative shifts from the present, questioning assumptions, new actors
- * Emerging patterns of value, many alternatives
- * Quantitative sense of time as defining moment

The change pathway

This emerges as the long term successor to business-as-usual. It grows from fringe activity in the present that introduces completely new ways of doing things but which turn out to be much better fitted to the world that is emerging than the dominant H1 systems.

We call these early manifestations "pockets of the future in the present

Horizon Two (H2)



Approach:

- * Looks both ways
- * Zone of innovation and turbulence
- * Sense of time as opportunity cost need for trade-offs


Our perceptions of stability change in the present


What we see is a pattern of transition activities and innovations, people trying things out in response to the ways in which the landscape is changing.


- Some of these innovations will be taken up by H1 systems to prolong their life while
- Some will pave the way for the emergence of the radically different H3 systems.


Three Horizons process


